

Project 10 – Smoke Portrait Effect

Assignment:

You will watch the video on my website (woodmathroom.weebly.com). This video is step-by-step for how you need to do your project. Upon completion you will have a portrait that portrays a smoke effect.

Final composition needs to focus on the Rule of Thirds and cropping for compositional interest.

You will export 2 photos for the smoke effect. One will show a black and white image of the smoke effect. The other will show a colored smoke effect.

The final product should have a mat style frame with three images; the original photo without smoke, the black and white smoke, and the colored smoke.

Be sure the mat style frame has a title across the top, and include a description of the project across the bottom of the frame.

Categories	Category description / points	Points
Project Name	Image should be named Project 10 – Smoke Portrait , and saved as a .jpg 3 points	
Photo Resolution	The final image has good resolution and does not appear pixelated. 3 Points	
Rule of Thirds	Each Image needs to have the Rule of Thirds applied to its Composition 3 Points, 1 for each image	
Cropping	Each image should be cropped in a way that adds interest to the composition 3 Points, 1 for each image	
Black/White Smoke Effect	Smoke Portrait Effect is achieved in the Black and White image. 6 Points	
Colored Smoke Effect	Colored Smoke is applied to the Black and White image. 3 Points	
Project Layout	The final product needs to have all three images with a black mat style frame. The frame needs to include the title across the top, and a written description across the bottom. 3 Points	
Written Description	There needs to be a written description included across the bottom of the final Product. This needs to describe what you did in the project, be sure to included techniques and tools used. 3 Points	
On Time	Project needs to be handed in on time -2 points for each day it is late
